

WASHINGTON – U.S. Rep. Jo Bonner (R-AL) today launched a new official website to provide constituents with improved online services and information.

“My staff and I have been working for the past several months to update our website with the goal of making it more user-friendly,” Bonner said today. “This new, and hopefully improved, website is now live on the internet, and I invite my constituents to visit.”

Among the many features, the new website includes detailed information on the following items: flag requests; U.S. Capitol tours, visiting Washington, D.C.; and dealing with federal bureaucracies. An enhanced student section provides an application for internships, information on service academy nominations, and provides younger children with educational resources. There are also sections that feature biographical information about Congressman Bonner; his official photo; and archived press releases, weekly columns, radio clips and newsletters.
