

MOBILE - U.S. Rep. Jo Bonner, R-Alabama, today announced the award of funding to the Oak Grove Volunteer Fire Department from the United States Department of Homeland Security and the United States Fire Administration (USFA). The grant, totaling \$19,107, is being made available through the USFA's Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program and will be used for the purpose of operations and firefighter safety.

"I am extremely pleased the Department of Homeland Security has approved this funding for the Oak Grove Volunteer Fire Department," Bonner said. The Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program provides one-year grant funding to local fire departments to assist them in improving the effectiveness of their operations.
