

MOBILE - U.S. Rep. Jo Bonner, R-Alabama, today announced the award of funding to the Epworth Volunteer Fire Department in Vinegar Bend from the United States Department of Homeland Security through the United States Fire Administration. The grant, totaling \$126,477, is being made available through the USFA's Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program and will be used for the purpose of fire operations and firefighter safety.
