

MOBILE - U.S. Rep. Jo Bonner, R-Alabama today announced the award of funding to the City of Mobile and Mobile County from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. According to HUD, the City of Mobile will be receiving three grants totaling \$5,097,938.00 to be used for the rehabilitation of single- and multi-family housing units, rental assistance, new housing construction, housing counseling, historic preservation, public facility renovation and public services. Additionally, Mobile County will be receiving three grants totaling \$3,568,059.00 to be used for the expansion of rural and urban housing communities and expanded economic opportunities for low- and moderate-income individuals and families.

"I am extremely pleased the Department of Housing and Urban Development has approved this funding for the City of Mobile and Mobile County," Bonner said. "As an area that is continuing to work to provide quality affordable housing for individuals and families, this funding will be of tremendous benefit as city and county officials work toward that end.
